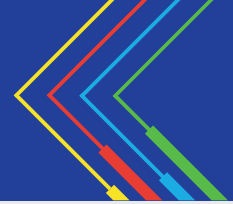


Hinkley Connection Project



We're installing underground electricity cables between the west end of Nailsea and Portishead substation. From February 2020, we will start work in your area to build temporary entrances, access roads and storage compounds as we prepare to construct the underground cables.

We will need to manage traffic on sections of Washing Pound Lane, Church Lane, Clevedon Road, Whitehouse Lane, Caswell Hill, Caswell Lane and Sheepway to keep road users, pedestrians and our workers safe. This will include using temporary traffic lights and short-term road closures.

The Hinkley Connection Project is a new 57 km high-voltage electricity connection between Bridgwater and Seabank near Avonmouth. It is a significant investment in the region's electricity network and will connect new sources of low-carbon energy, including EDF Energy's Hinkley Point C, to homes and businesses.

Our work between Nailsea and Portishead includes:

Installing underground cables

- Constructing 10.5 km underground cables between the west end of Nailsea and Portishead substation.

Working with WPD to remove existing pylons as a direct result of community feedback:

- Between Nailsea and Portishead substation.
- From the A368 in Sandford to Avonmouth.

T-pylons

- Building T-pylons from the west of Nailsea to Portishead as part of the new overhead line between Sandford and Seabank substations.
