Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended' and of all other enabling powers, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit waiting and loading to all vehicles on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and enforcement of the restrictions.

This order is required because of the need to implement measures for public safety in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. This order will become operative on the 12th December 2020 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated in response to the Covid-19 situation. Appropriate traffic signs and/or road markings will be displayed when and where the measures are in force.
