North Somerset Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under section 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief office of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on the xxxxxx 2020 and may be cited as the North Somerset Council (Whitehouse Lane, Caswell Lane and Caswell Hill, Portbury, Wraxall & Failand, North Somerset) (30mph & 40mph Speed Limits) Order 2020.
2. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
3. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

30mph Speed Limit

Whitehouse Lane From a point approximately 160metres south of its junction with Caswell Hill in a southerly direction for approximately 155metres.

SCHEDULE 2

40mph Speed Limit

Whitehouse Lane From a point approximately 70metres south of its junction with Caswell Hill in a southerly direction for approximately 90metres.

Whitehouse Lane From a point approximately 315metres south of its junction with Caswell Hill in a southerly direction for approximately 70metres.

Caswell Lane From a point approximately 220m east of its junction with Caswell Hill to a point 120m west of the junction.

Caswell Hill From its junction with Caswell Lane in a southerly direction for approximately 120m.
