

Whitehouse Lane is an approved crossing point for construction vehicles as part of the Hinkley Connection Project.

From Monday 6 July, we need to clear vegetation, install road signs and an anti-skid surface on Whitehouse Lane as we prepare to construct the crossing point.

To carry out the work safely, there will be temporary traffic lights on Whitehouse Lane for approximately 10 days.

We recognise this work will cause disruption to journeys and we're sorry for any inconvenience. We are working with our contractors, Murphy, to get this work completed as quickly as possible.

From 27 July 2020, this crossing point will be controlled by manually operated traffic lights during working hours only. We will remove the lights when all our work in this area is complete.

The temporary traffic access points, haul roads and crossing points allow us to move traffic off main roads directly into the construction areas.

The traffic management has been coordinated and agreed with the local Highway Authority. Our priority is safety of the public and our staff.
