

WRAXALL & FAILAND PARISH COUNCIL - A POLL

TO All residents

The Parish Plan, published a few years ago, highlighted the wish of residents for improvements to the footpath network through the Parish. The Council formed a Footpath Committee, and considerable work has been done to address this issue.

A new riverside walk has been created along the Land Yeo, thanks to local landowners. A path enabling walkers to walk through Wraxall away from the busy B3130 is currently being considered. Again, thanks to the generosity of the landowners, possible route(s) have been identified, as shown in the map over leaf.

Most of the land has been donated, but it is estimated that it will cost in excess of £20,000 to complete the footpath (fences, surfacing etc.) shown as the Northern route in red. Local businesses will be approached to consider financial support from their Community funds, once the project is underway.

The Council is suggesting raising £20,000 via the Parish precept, as a one-off payment. This would equate to £17.70 for a D-rated property. The precept is collected on behalf of the Parish by North Somerset Council, as part of the Council Tax.

The alternative Southern route, in blue, is a permissive path on offer and subject to final agreement.

The Parish Council is offering all residents on the Electoral Roll the opportunity to vote on this proposal, and you are urged to respond, whether you support or oppose the idea.
