

Wraxall CE Primary School Governor Vacancies

We are looking for new governors to join the governing body of our small, friendly primary school in Wraxall. Our governing body is made up of parent governors, foundation governors (who support the Christian character of the school), staff governors and co-opted (community) governors. We are fortunate to have engaged governors with a range of different skills and experience, but we currently have vacancies for foundation and co-opted governors.

The role of the governing body is to ensure clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction; to hold the school's leaders to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils; to oversee the financial performance of the school and make sure money is well spent.

Governance usually requires a commitment of 6-8 hours per month (term time only) and includes attending meetings and training courses, and monitoring a link area within the school, e.g. Numeracy, Literacy, Special Educational Needs, Safeguarding, Finance.

- Has spare time and the energy for the role
- Has an enquiring mind and the confidence to ask questions and debate issues that affect the school
