NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - Section 14 Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order Sandy Lane, Lower Failand, North Somerset Temporary Prohibition of Use By Vehicles Order 2018 Date coming Into Force: 2nd July 2018

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules to this Notice.

Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and when works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Gigaclear Limited to install fibre micro duct. This will become operative on 2 July 2018 in two phases for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be in Phase One in the lengths of roads noted in Schedule One for one week in duration. In Phase Two in the lengths of roads noted in Schedule Two to become operative on 9 July 2018 or on completion of Phase One (whichever is the earliest and subject to any engineering issues delaying Phase Two) and anticipated to be of seven weeks in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule One (Phase One)

Pill Road (A369), Harris Lane, Manor Lane and vice versa.

Schedule Two (Phase Two)

Common Lane, Happerton Lane, Martcombe Road (A369), Haberfield Hill (A369), Pill Road (A369), Sandy Lane (part unaffected) and vice versa.

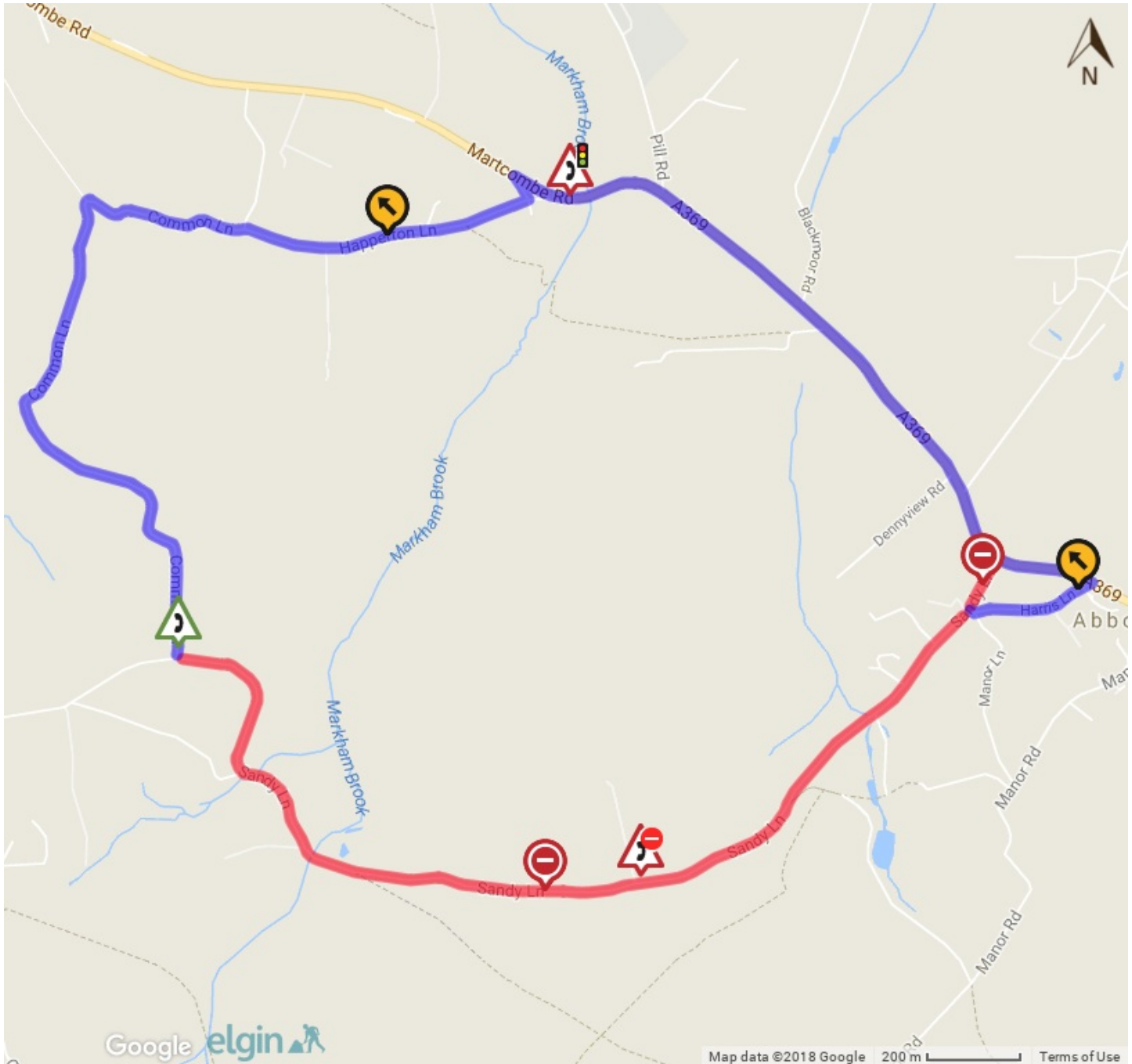
